## *Live Auction*

The live auction will begin at approximately 6:15PM. This catalogue has all the numbers, titles, artists that correspond with the works to be auctioned. They will be offered in numerical order. On the back of this catalogue is your bidding number. Whenever you wish to agree to a bid, you must raise your number so that the auctioneer can recognize you. The last person to bid will win the item and may pay for it with cash or check at the front table by the entry. You may take your item only if you have paid for it. It will be in its original space with a "sold" dot on the tag next to it.

## *Silent Auction*

Each piece is clearly marked as a silent auction piece with a form next to it. Each piece has a number and a title that corresponds to the information in this catalogue. You will see where to write in your bid on the form. At the end of the concert there will be about twenty minutes more time for placing your final bids at the silent auction. Once the silent auction ends, the bidding will be closed. The silent auction manager will pick up all the forms and the winners will be announced. Please pay check or cash for the item to Dan Dixon at the front table.

## Peppino D'Agostino

Peppino D'Agostino is not your conventional steel-string acoustic guitarist. He cannot be pinned down to a particular style. And that's exactly the way the internationally acclaimed virtuoso wants it.

The Italian native and Benicia resident's latest project is 'Bayshore Road,' a collaboration with his friend and studio partner, electric guitarist Stef Burns, and it serves as a perfect example of his diversity. D'Agostino's style incorporates both standard and unconventional tunings as well as unique fingering and percussive effects.

"I'm not just an acoustic guitar player. I've played with classical and jazz guitarists," D'Agostino said. "What I'm trying to do is stretch the boundaries of this instrument. I think of myself as more than just an acoustic guitar player. I'm an entertainer, singer and guitarist who plays a lot of different styles. I also enjoy teaching guitar, and I've done instructional books and videos. Ultimately, my mission is to touch people in a heartfelt way both emotionally and intellectually."

## Gordon Rowland

Gordon began flamenco guitar studies while in grade school, continuing music studies at U. of Idaho and Boise State University. He later studied with Michael Lorrimer at U.C Berkeley, Master classes with Christopher Parkening, and Oscar Giglia and was invited to attend a Masters Class of Andres Segovia.

His teaching includes Master classes and workshops, posts at The College of Idaho and Treasure Valley Community College in Ontario Oregon. Gordon is the music education director for Music for Children, a nonprofit that provides guitars and lessons for underprivileged children.

Compositions include *The Salmon River Suite*; *The Castle Suite* included on a recent CD; and works of *Albeniz, Bach, Beethoven, Sor and Tarrega* included on his CD (Masterworks).
